



PKAVS vision is a Perth and Kinross where all communities are inclusive and connected, and local people are helped to reach their potential. PKAV's Carers Hub offers support to young carers aged 5-15 and young adult carers aged 16-24. All of their services offer practical and emotional support, advocacy, as well as training and information. PKAVS works with schools to identify and support young carers in an educational setting. Their Education Attainment Service was set up a year ago to support young people who are disengaging with education. The services is open to young carers aged 5-18 and offers homework clubs, remote access to study supports, a tutoring service and emotional / practical support to help with engagement – including access to digital hardware and software.

Direct Impact 57 young people accessed individual coaching support through the Education Attainment Service over the last 12 months. All of those involved improved their engagement in learning and developed their skills. 54 out of 57 made progress in literacy and numeracy and more than half took steps to overcome barriers to learning and improved their health and wellbeing.
